Introduction with a detailed explanation of the context of study/research/project and the objectives along with

Research Background, a clear statement of the problem to be solved and the proposed solutions by highlighting the significant contribution and the novelty of the work done;

Research Method – should be concise, clear and complete that facilitate others to reproduce;

Results and Discussion – Include the essential findings, results obtained, and comparison with previous findings by other researchers. Explain all figures, tables and graphs/plots in this section based on the results obtained and cite accordingly with relevant references. All tables, figures and charts are created using MS Word, and all figures MUST be in high-quality images.

Conclusion – Summarise the primary outcomes of the research/work/study, and all claims made are supported by results/findings. Relate the significant knowledge of your work/study/project.
