

Ethics Policy for Publications

Ethics Policy for Publishing in the Conference Proceeding of the 3rd International Conference of the World Academy of Islamic Management

Authors are required to:

- Ensure that all submitted research work is original, prepared to a high scholarly standard, and fully referenced using the prescribed referencing system.
- Represent his/herself accurately, and other appropriate acknowledgements are clearly stated, including funding sources.
- Disclose the source of all data and how it was acquired.
- Certify that all the data has been acquired according to recognised ethical research practices.
- Correspond and promptly comply with the editor(s) and publisher(s) in any requests for source data, proof of authorship, or originality.
- Co-operate with any consequent investigations if any issues are raised by reviewers, editors, or the Conference organiser.
- Provide appropriate information for errata if such an event occurs.
- Remain in good communication with the editor(s), publisher, and co-authors if needed.
- Recognise that the Editorial Board of the Conference Proceeding has the final decision to publish.
