



## GUIDELINES FOR BiLD LAW JOURNAL (SCOPUS INDEXED JOURNAL)

1. Authors **must present in ICO-ISOL 2023** to be **eligible for consideration** of paper evaluation in this Special Issue.
2. Paper must follow the Special Issue theme: **Social Sciences and Law**
3. All submitted papers will be proposed to the BiLD Law Journal by the ICO-ISOL 2023 organiser via Guest Editors and subject to the reviewers' and editors' decision.
4. This entire review process will take anywhere between 4 and 6 months after submission of the manuscript. The review process is treated confidentially at all times. The Guest Editors' decision is final.
5. Upon acceptance of the papers, authors are required to pay for the processing and publication fees.

The fees **do not cover ICO-ISOL 2023 conference registration**. Language editing cost will be borne by authors, if any.

6. Upon rejection, the paper will be suggested to MyCITE/ERA indexed journal with processing fee of RM 100/ USD 25 and publication fee will be waived (free publication fee).
7. This Special Issue only publishes unpublished original research articles in **English language**.
8. The article **must not exceed 8000 words**. The shorter articles are also welcome.
9. The methodology of writing must be of an academic writing and the references must be written properly.
10. All articles submitted to this Special Issue will be initially assessed by the Guest Editors for suitability for the journal. Articles deemed suitable are then sent to a minimum of two independent expert reviewers in the field.
11. All articles published in the journal are not necessarily represented the idea of the journal, neither of the ICO-ISOL Organiser. The writer is fully responsible of his views and article.
12. The copyright of the article published in the journal belongs to the journal. It can be reprinted with a proper acknowledgement that it was published in the journal.
