

MiGC15: GUIDELINES FOR ORAL & e-POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Oral Presentation

General Instructions:

- a) Each oral presenter is allocated with **10 minutes** for presentation and **~3 minutes** for a Q&A session.
- b) Presentation must be prepared in the PowerPoint format (.ppt)
- c) A Q&A session will be held either at the end of your presentation or at the end of every break-up session
- d) A session chair will moderate the overall flow of the presentation session

Oral presentations are divided into two types:

- a) On-site (Physical) Presentation

Notes for presenters:

- (i) Please be at the venue of your session 15 minutes before the session starts
- (ii) Please upload your presentation slides in advance (at least a session away from your presentation slot).

- b) On-line Presentation

Online presenters are given 2 (two) options to present:

- (i) Pre-recorded Presentation

- You may record a 10-minute video of your PowerPoint presentation
- Please email the recorded video to migc.secretariat@gmail.com by **27th February 2023**
- The submitted video will be played during your presentation slot
- You are required to stay online during your presentation slot until the end of the Q&A session

- (ii) Live Presentation

Presenters who opted for this presentation mode are subjected to the general presentation rules above. You are advised to be wary of technical glitches that might be occurring during your presentation slot primarily due to the internet connection problem. Please ensure that this can be rectified sooner if it were to happen at your end.

Best Oral Presentation Award

Oral Presentation Competition is opened to **student participants ONLY**. Judging process will be held on the **7th March 2023** (Day 1 of the Congress).

e-Poster Presentation:

All posters accepted for MiGC15 will be displayed in the digital format (e-Poster) only on a screen monitor situated at the Conference Hall throughout the conference. e-Posters can also be accessed using the QR Code that will be displayed in the Conference Hall. Online participants can get the access to the e-Posters by clicking the link provided in our e-Programme Book and in the 'chat room'. No Q&A slots will be dedicated to e-poster presenters during the event. Participants who are interested to engage with poster authors can reach them via email (listed in our Programme Book).

Presenters are advised to follow the instructions given below:

- a) Posters must be prepared in English
- b) Poster size: A4 (210 x 297 mm); Poster orientation: Portrait (vertical)
- c) Poster content must adhere to the following subheadings:
 - Introduction
 - Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results and Discussion
 - Conclusion
- d) Each poster submission must be accompanied with a **three (3) -minute** video presentation

e-Poster Submission

A PDF file of your poster and recorded presentation video must be submitted via email to migc.secretariat@gmail.com before **17th February 2023**. Name your file according to this format: Paper ID_surname of the first author_ track (Eg. 001-001_Ahmad_Food and Agriculture). If you intend to share a link to your submission, kindly ensure the accessibility of the shared link.

Best Poster Award

Best poster competition is opened to **ALL poster presenters**. The judging process will begin on **20th February 2023**.
